8 Otaru Aquarium

One of Asia's leading aquariums with approximately 300 species of marine life, 20,000 fish and amphibians. The dolphin shows are popular. Location: Shukutsu 3-303. Tel. (0134) 33-1400. Late Mar. - late Nov. 9:00 am -

5:00 pm every day (may change slightly according to season). Adults: ¥1,300, 6-15: ¥530, 3-5: ¥210, U-3: Free. #10 or #11 Chuo Bus from JR Otaru Sta., 1-min. walk from terminus


9 Asarigawa Spa **Asari Dam Lakeside Park**

10 Mt. Tengu Ropeway (Cable Car)

11 Mt. Kenashi Viewpoint

Small car park by the side of Rte. 393. The view of Otaru is great, particularly at night. 20 min by car on Rte. 393 toward Akaigawa Village.



12 Otaru City Nishin Goten (built 1897)

Built during the most prosperous period in the history of Otaru's fishing industry, this large-scale dormitory provided accommodation for herring fishermen at the time. The interior houses equipment used in their work and day-to-day lives, as well as photographs and important data from the era. Designated as a tangible cultural property of Hokkaido. Location: Shukutsu 3-228. Tel. (0134) 22-1038. Early Apr. ~ late Nov. 9:00 am - 5:00 pm every day. Adults: ¥300. High school students: ¥150. #10 or #11 Chuo Bus from JR Otaru Sta.


